Heather was instructed by Morrish & Co Solicitors to act for Claimant Rachael Presdee in her claim against Soho Theatre, following an accident at work in 2012 that left her paralysed. Led by Stuart Brown QC (since retired), the team secured a sum close to £3.7m in damages at a JSM. Heather drafted the schedule of special damages.
